

2007 Student Assistance Program Evaluation/Research Award Nomination Form

Please use this nomination form for the 2007 Student Assistance Program Evaluation/Research Award. This annual award will honor an individual or group who has made an outstanding contribution in conducting a program evaluation/research study in the SAP field, which may serve as a model for other programs, and studies. The recipient will be honored at the Awards Banquet during the National Student Assistance Conference in March of 2007 in Orlando, FL. Recipients of this award during the past three years are not eligible to apply.

Application Procedures:

- A. Submit an abstract of the research study or program evaluation. Please include the following in the abstract:
1. At the top of the abstract, please list the following: Title of Evaluation/Research, Contact Person's Name and Title, School/College/Affiliation, Complete Address, Phone, Fax, and Email.
 2. The abstract should include a brief description of the study including the purpose of the study, commencement and ending dates of the study, setting and subjects, methodology, bulleted list of results, bulleted list of conclusions this study may have regarding quality improvement of SAPs, and a statement of the significance of the study.
 3. Please include a brief description of how you have or are planning for disseminating the finding of your study or evaluation.

The above items should be typed in a 12-point font size on single-sided pages, preferably double-spaced. The abstract should be no more than four pages total.

- B. Provide a copy of the bibliography used in your study or evaluation.
- C. If the study has been published, please include a photocopy of the published article.

All applications must be postmarked by January 15, 2007.
